Frame: Supporting the Science- and Policy-Based Process on DSI



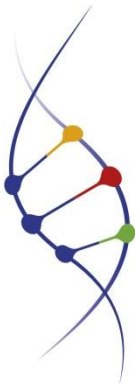
- **COP 14** acknowledged divergence of opinions on DSI and called for **Science-Policy Process** and further consultations

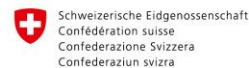
