### Outcome One: Updated NBSAPs

#### National NBSAP activities can include:

- 1. Implementing comprehensive NBSAP stakeholder engagement to promote whole-of-government and whole-of-society approaches.
- 2. Enabling gender mainstreaming within consultation processes and within the NBSAP.
- 3. Identifying and prioritizing gaps and inconsistencies between the NBSAP and achieving the GBF.
- 4. Strengthening biodiversity policy alignment, coherence, and mainstreaming into key sectors.
- 5. Strengthening readiness for NBSAP implementation.
- 6. Undertaking, as needed, integrated spatial planning for the NBSAP.
- 7. Developing, as needed, action plans to support the NBSAP.
- 8. Undertaking, as needed, planning processes for capacity development, resource mobilization, and monitoring and evaluation.

### Outcome Three: Global, regional and national support – Help Desk Services

Help Desk services: An ongoing help desk is available to Parties to receive support throughout the programme in 4 languages (English, French, Russian, Spanish) in a timely manner (Output 3.1).

- Customized regionally responsive support to Party needs
- On demand review of national documents using CBD criteria for NBSAP and NR
- 3. Assessment and adaptive management of programme activities
- 4. Regular assessment of national programme activities and delivery to enable adaptive management
- Support provided to access partner matchmaking services
